Important Information about Paying for Your Care at NYU Hospitals Center

Multiple Bills

It is important for you to know that the hospital only bills you for hospital services. You will also get bills from doctors. Doctors who care for you at the hospital may work in a private practice or they may be employed by the medical center. Some of these doctors may not be in the same health plan networks as the hospital. Ask the doctor admitting you to the hospital or scheduling your outpatient care if they participate in your insurance plan's network. If a doctor or hospital is not in your plan's network, your plan will require you to pay more.

In-Network Insurance Coverage: Hospital Benefits

NYU Hospitals Center participates in many health plan networks. Each health plan creates a network of doctors and hospitals who have agreed to be in that network. We say they "participate" in the plan. You can find a list of the plans in which we participate at www.nyulangone.org/insurance-billing. Some health plans use smaller networks for certain services so it is important to check whether we participate in the specific plan that covers you. Our list will tell you if we are in a health plan's network.

In-Network Insurance Coverage: Physician Benefits

You can look online to see if your doctors work for NYU Langone Medical Center, which includes NYU Hospitals Center, and if your doctors are part of the same networks as the Hospital. You can find information for all of these doctors, including employed anesthesiologists, pathologists and radiologists, at www.nyulangone.org/doctors.

You should check with the doctor admitting you to the hospital or scheduling your outpatient care to find out if you might need to have any other doctors involved in your care. Your doctor can give you their name, practice name, mailing address and telephone number. Your doctor will also be able to tell you if you are likely to need the services of any doctors employed by NYU Langone Medical Center, in which case you can obtain information at the above link.

Out-of-Pocket Costs
